## 2013-14 BTS MEN'S PENNANT ROSTERS

The 8-nations Jackaroos team includes Mark Casey (NSW), Kelsey Cottrell (NSW), Karen Murphy (NSW), [a few new names] Matthew Flapper (VIC), Carla Odgers (VIC), Barrie Lester (VIC), Rebecca Van Asch (Nee: Quail) (TAS), Nathan Rice (QLD), Claire Turley (Nee: Duke) (NSW), Wayne Ruediger (SA), Aron Sherriff (NSW), Natasha Van Eldik (NSW) and Brett Wilkie (QLD).

The Bowlers with a Vision Impairment mixed pairs team includes Marian Morrison and Tony Scott, while the Para-Sport triples line-up features Joshua Barry, Anthony Bonnell, Barry Charity and Tim Slater.

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29 July—1 Aug the **Australian Indoor Championship singles** at Tweed Heads with \$30,000 in prize money. Men's singles won by Tony Wood 9-6 + 9-3 over Mark Nitz and Karen Murphy won by 10-4 + 10-4 over Maria Rigby. This is Karen's 6th Indoor title and she is the world's reigning singles champion.

### 2013-14 PENNANT SEASON

**BTS Women's Thursday Pennant:** the roster commences on Thursday 10 October with the final round on Thursday 13 March, 2014. Semi Finals: 18 March Preliminary Finals: 19 March, and Grand Finals 20 March, 2014

**BTS Men's Midweek Pennant:** the roster commences on Wednesday 9 October with the final round on 5 March, 2014. Semi Finals: 12 March, Preliminary Finals: 19 March, and Grand Finals 26 March, 2014.

**BTS Men's Saturday Pennant:** roster starts on Saturday 12 October and concludes on Saturday 1 March, 2014. Semi Finals: 15 March, Preliminary Finals: 22 March, and Grand Finals 5 April, 2014.

There will be a **three week break over the Christmas-New Year** period with the final round before Christmas being: Men's Midweek (11 December), Women's (12 December) and Men's Saturday (December 14). Rosters recommence in January: Women's (9 January), Men's Saturday (11 January) and Men's Midweek (15 January).

Southern Tasmanian Bowls Association formed in 1905 as the controlling body of bowls in the south of the State is now trading as **BOWLS TASMANIA SOUTH**.

Approximately 47% of the State's bowlers belong to southern clubs. Their official web site is now weretire.com.au however no information is as yet available on it.

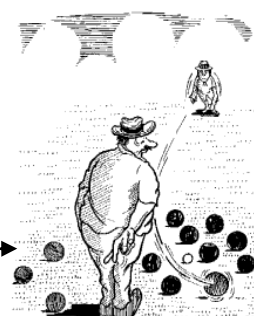

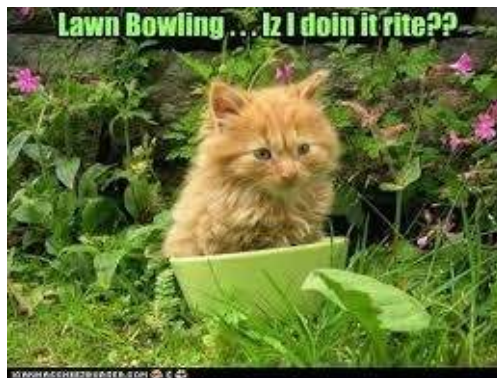
