## **ENTRIES CLOSE 30 JANUARY, 2014**

UPGRADES TO THE KITCHEN	RECENT ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE BOARD
In view of the new catering arrangements, and the greater usage of the Club's kitchen facilities that has occurred it has become very apparent that there are a number of improvements/equipment upgrades necessary. As a result of a review of needs it has been decided to purchase and install a new 1200l two-door refrigerator. This should ensure sufficient cool storage capacity to meet the needs of our caterers, as well as for our lady members. Further improvements will consist of a new canopy and extractor fan over the cooking area, and a new commercial deep fryer. These latter improvements will occur when funding is available to enable the work to proceed, and the purchase to be made.	A letter has been written to BTS requesting the Section 3.21 (which states that at least 50% of matches in a division must be completed before points are allotted) be deleted from BTS Conditions of Play for 2014-15, because it disadvantages clubs that are able to complete their matches. The Board has also requested meetings with Kingborough Councillors, and with the Executive of BTS to discuss matters in relation to the Kingborough Indoor Bowls Centre. The workshop with Kingborough Councillors will occur, most likely, during the latter part of February.
